GUIDANCE FOR ENTRANTS

It is Woburn Sands Town Council's aim to make this competition really easy to enter. We are keen to know what your environmental action is so that we can reward you with a certificate or a prize for your efforts. Please complete this entry form so we know a little bit more about you and your environmental action. Remember, if you're 15 or under we need your parent or guardian's permission for you to enter and you may need their help completing the entry form and that is ok – just tell them what to write so it is in all your own words.

What do you need to do?

You need to fill in the entry form and get it to Woburn Sands Town Council. The competition is open to entries from the start of February 2022. The completed entry form needs to reach us along with evidence of your activity **no later than 5pm on 29th April 2022**. Your evidence must have your name and age on it.

What if you can't think of an action or activity?

Woburn Sands Town Council have a page on our website www.woburnsands.org.uk dedicated to the Young Environmentalist Awards. You'll find some ideas and links to other resources on the internet that just might inspire you.

What do we mean by evidence?

You can capture and report on your environmental action/activity in a number of ways. For example you may use visual evidence such as photographs, drawings or posters (up to A2 in size) or a short video (up to 10 minutes long). You might produce a collage to show what you've done, a small model or plan, or a small piece of artwork.

You might want to provide us with written evidence such as an illustrated essay describing the action or journal or diary entries or a project log.

Remember, these are just some suggestions. You might want to make use of new technologies and produce a vlog (up to 10 minutes long). The choice is up to you.

You've completed the entry form – now what?

We've tried to make it as easy as possible for you to submit your entry form and evidence. If your evidence is digital then you can email both the entry form and the evidence to YEA@wstc.org.uk. If your evidence is mostly photographs or a video, then putting them on a memory stick may be more appropriate.

You can send it via post to Woburn Sands Young Environmentalist Awards, Woburn Sands Town Council, The Memorial Hall, 4 High Street, Woburn Sands, MK17 8RH.

You can deliver by hand to the Town Council office on the High Street. There is a secure letterbox on the front of the Memorial Hall doors which you can use to do this. If your evidence will not fit through the letterbox then it can be handed in at our office which is alongside the Memorial Hall. The office will be open to receive entries 10am to 1pm Monday to Thursday.
